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### **INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICIAN**

#### **Position Purpose**

The Industrial Electrician is responsible for troubleshooting, repairing and maintaining the electrical systems throughout LHM's facility. Their main objective is the preventative and corrective maintenance of various Computer Numerical Controlled (CNC) machines.

#### **Job Description / Responsibilities**

- Safely and efficiently operate and maintain plant facilities and equipment.
- Follow established Company Health, Safety and Environmental policies and procedures.
- Respond to emergency situations as required.
- Identify inefficiencies and potential electrical problems while coordinating with the supervisor to determine optimal solutions. Including deviations from established procedures.
- Plan installations from prints, sketches and specifications and install electrical and electronic devices.
- Systematically diagnose faults in electrical and electronic systems and equipment and repairs or replaces components as required.
- Troubleshoot electrical and electronic systems and controls for proper function.
- Carry out preventative maintenance programs such as upgrading dated wiring and devices, cleaning contacts, circuit boards and electrical panels.
- Measure, cut, thread, assemble and install conduits and other electrical conductor raceways.
- Splice and terminate electrical conductors.
- Documenting and maintaining records pertaining to work conducted.
- Please note that the duties and responsibilities outlined are not exhaustive and that you may be expected to perform other reasonable duties and responsibilities should the need arise.
- Report directly to Maintenance Manager.

#### **Qualifications, Skills & Abilities Required**

- Industrial Electrician License (5 years experience preferred).
- Experience with CNC machines preferred.
- Electrical background is essential with prior experience using PLCs.
- Ability to install, troubleshoot, and maintain electrical and electronic components such as motors, switches, AC drives, PLCs, robots and sensors.

- Ability to use basic hand and power tools.
- Ability to use electronic test equipment.
- Professionalism and service orientation.
- Strong listening skills and detail-oriented.
- Interpersonal skills (communicating and working effectively with others and influencing skills).
- Strong problem solving and decision making abilities.
- Demonstrate strong time management skills with the ability to effectively coordinate multiple projects.
